First, you need an account at jockeyclub.com. This is your login for both the website and app.

Next:

Download **ID My Thoroughbred** app

Enter your horse's microchip #

- If they pop up, click Registration Markings & Photos



TIP OF THE MONTH

Then, if nothing comes up:

Visit [The Jockey Club website](http://TheJockeyClub.com)

Create an account - Visit the Registry - "Microchip Lookup, Request & Reporting"



Enter:

- Enter registered name (race name or other registry name), year of birth, and dam's name
- Then, add microchip number and implant date (use 2nd birthday if unsure), submit, then return to the app — it should work right away
